Sweet Beauty Watermelon is an annual vegetable plant that is commonly grown for its edible qualities. It produces dark green oblong fruit with green stripes and red flesh which are typically harvested when mature. The fruits have a sweet taste and a juicy texture.

Planting & Growing

Sweet Beauty Watermelon will grow to be about 3 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 9 feet. Because of its vigorous growth habit, it may require staking or supplemental support. This vegetable plant is an annual, which means that it will grow for one season in your garden and then die after producing a crop.

This plant is typically grown in a designated vegetable garden. It should only be grown in full sunlight. It does best in average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. It may require supplemental watering during periods of drought or extended heat. It is not particular as to soil pH, but grows best in rich soils. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. Consider applying a thick mulch around the root zone over the growing season to conserve soil moisture. This is a selected variety of a species not originally from North America.
